OVERVIEW AND OBJECTIVES

The Ohio FFA Foundation is hiring two interns as a part of the Agriscience Internship Program. This internship is an intensive program to prepare current college students for careers as agricultural educators. This professional development opportunity will expose students studying agricultural education to all aspects of Team Ag Ed. After participating in the program, students will gain knowledge in technical content, organizational structure and real teaching experiences.

One internship position will focus primarily on recruiting and retaining agricultural educators in Ohio. The second position will assist in the development and execution of professional development opportunities for pre-service and current educators. Interns will have many unique opportunities to assist with agricultural education efforts in Ohio!
